ISI Group has six Japanese language schools, two vocational schools and one university. It also provides study abroad services as a general education group. The company celebrated its 45th anniversary in 2022.







This course is available for those with the intention of studying from 1 year and 3 months to a maximum of 2 years with a student visa.

\* Harajuku Campus is 1 to 2 years, and Nagano Campus is 1 year and 6 months to 2 years.



## Academic Support from Admission to Graduation (April enrollment, 2-year course)



## Employment Support Process from Enrollment to Graduation (April enrollment, 1-year course)




